

Prescription Drug Program – Express Scripts Pharmacy

Effective January 1, 2012, Express Scripts will be the new pharmacy benefit manager (replacing Medco). You can get your prescription filled at a participating retail pharmacy or home-delivered through mail order.

An Express Scripts Drug Card will be sent to you to specifically use for prescriptions. You can access Express Scripts online at www.express-scripts.com, for prescription history, order refills, price a drug, or as a resource tool for drug and health information.

- Prescriptions can be filled at a participating retail pharmacy (such as CVS, Rite Aid, Wal-Mart, etc.). Present your Express Scripts drug card at the time your prescription is filled.
- View your prescription claims and order refills using the Express Scripts website address www.express-scripts.com.
- With mail order, you can take advantage of a ninety (90) day supply of maintenance medication (i.e. blood pressure, birth control, allergy, etc.) for the cost of two (2) copays.
- If you have questions about your prescription coverage, contact Express Scripts customer service at 1-877-512-1319.
 - Drug formulary may differ than Medco, which may cause an increase or decrease in your copay amount depending on the drug tier (generic, formulary, or non-formulary/specialty drug).
 - If you are currently using mail order with Medco, you will need to submit a new prescription to Express Scripts

If you use mail order, please make sure you have a sufficient supply of your prescription on hand prior to the start of the new plan year to allow Express Scripts time to process and deliver your prescription refill order
