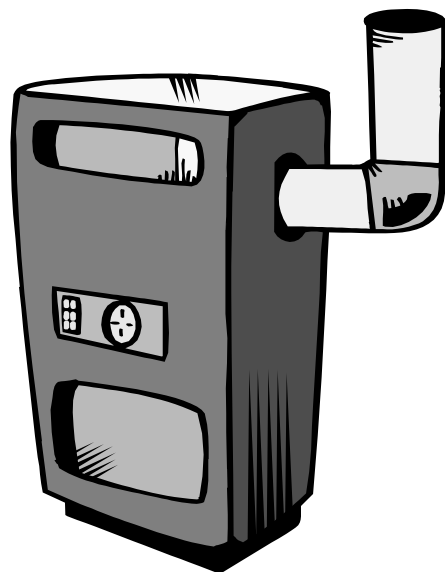

2012 Code Changes

In our next Monthly newsletter we will start updating you on the 2012 North Carolina Mechanical and Fuel Gas Code changes. The North Carolina Energy Conservation Code and Residential Building Codes are not printed at this time, They should be available in January 2012. We will post the changes for Those Codes when we receive them.

PERMIT INFORMATION

Please provide us with good contact information on your permits such as contact numbers, property owners or tenants and cross streets. In some cases the cross streets are very important because it may be a new development and the street address may not be on our map or may not show up on GPS. There are information blocks on the permit for this information to be provided. This will help us get your inspection completed in a timely manner.



PROPERTY OWNER INFORMATION

If you have an existing occupied property that you are working in and we will need to gain access into that property, please let the owner or tenant know that we will be contacting them to gain access into the property to perform your inspection. We have some cases where the owners say that no one has told them about an inspection being required and they are not expecting us to contact them. This also will help us get your inspection completed in a timely manner.
