

My Community Map

Instructions:

1. Put your name on the back of the map. Print your first and last name.
2. You may want to draw all your buildings, houses and other places in pencil first in case you need to change something on your map.
3. As the developer of your community you will need to answer the following questions:
 -  What will your community look like?
 -  Where will the people work? What type of work will be available?
 -  Where will families, the elderly and single people live?
 -  Will your community have fun things to do?
 -  Will there be some type of transportation service? (taxi, bus, or train)
 -  Will people shop or eat out in your community?
4. Add the following to your Community map:
 - Name your community. Write the name at the top of your map. If you live in a neighborhood that already has a name you may use it or chose a name that you like for the neighborhood
 - Name the streets and roads in your community
 - Name the river that is in the community
 - Draw your house in the community. Where will you live in the community?
 - Draw places you would like to have in your community such as restaurants, stores, parks, churches, a swimming pool, a shopping center, and other places that you would enjoy spending time with your friends and family.
 - Add the name of those places either on the map beside the place or put a number beside the place and write the name on the back of your map.
5. Color all the places on your map. Use colored pencils or crayons on the map.
6. When you finish your Community Map put it back in the envelope that your model came in and return it to your teacher.

The map will be reviewed by the planning staff and returned to you with comments about your design for the community. Remember to be creative and do your best work. Your map will help us to understand your vision for what you think your community should like in the future.
