

DEAD ANIMAL CONTROL WORKER

DEFINITION OF WORK

Under immediate supervision, performs responsible semi-skilled work in the collection and disposal of dead animals; does related work as required.

EXAMPLES OF WORK

Collects dead animals from City streets, veterinarian hospitals and fish markets; disposes of dead animals in the City landfill; operates and maintains equipment necessary for the collection and disposal of dead animals; may assist with Sanitation Collection.

EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS

Education and Experience: Any combination of education and experience equivalent to completion of the eleventh grade and experience in the operation of motorized equipment.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: General knowledge of the principles and practices of operating and servicing trucks and related medium equipment; general knowledge of the traffic laws and regulations governing equipment operation; general knowledge of the occupational hazards involved and the safety precautions necessary to the proper operation of varied equipment; ability to understand and follow oral and written directions; mechanical aptitude; ability to make minor repairs and adjustments to equipment; works independently.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT

Possession of a valid North Carolina driver's license.
