

EROSION CONTROL INSPECTOR - 299

DEFINITION OF WORK

Under immediate supervision, performs responsible technical work in enforcing erosion and flood ordinances section of the UDO; does related work as required.

EXAMPLES OF WORK

Provides pre-planning assistance to developers, architects and builders concerning erosion control and flood requirements; reviews plans to determine adherence to legal requirements; performs on-site inspections; determines if all graded areas are properly stabilized; sends violation notices; testifies in court; prepares periodic reports. Ensures that structures are constructed above adopted flood levels, coordinates with zoning enforcement section to ensure that erosion control permits do not conflict with zoning ordinances.

EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS

Education and Experience: Any combination of education and experience equivalent to an associate's degree in civil engineering, landscape architecture or a related field and some experience in grading and landscape work.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: Thorough knowledge of the principles and practices of erosion and sedimentation control; thorough knowledge of erosion and flood control laws; ability to provide technical assistance to the public; ability to enforce ordinances with firmness, tact and impartiality.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT

Possession of a valid North Carolina driver's license.
