

INDUSTRIAL WASTE CONTROL TECHNICIAN - 312

DEFINITION OF WORK

Under immediate supervision, performs routine technical work assisting in the operation of the industrial waste program; does related work as required.

EXAMPLES OF WORK

Collects time composite samples of industrial discharges for laboratory analysis; performs basic analytical tests and samples such as pH, temperature and visual appearance; calibrates flow meters; checks the operation of testing equipment; reads gauges, dials and other instruments and records pertinent information; checks operation and performs basic maintenance of flow meters, pH meters, samplers and pumps; checks operation and maintenance of various industrial waste control; operates the industrial waste trailer; keeps records and prepares basic reports on work activity.

EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS

Education and Experience: Any combination of education and experience equivalent to a high school diploma; some courses in chemistry and mechanical or laboratory experience are preferred.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: Some knowledge of materials, methods and tools used in wastewater treatment operations; ability to use basic hand tools in the maintenance and repair of equipment; ability to read data from gauges and meters; ability to take samples and run basic laboratory tests; ability to establish effective working relationships with others.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

Possession of a valid North Carolina driver's license.
