

## **LAKE ATTENDANT - 541**

### **DEFINITION OF WORK**

Under immediate supervision, performs routine protective service work in patrolling Salem Lake and related city properties to enforce the laws, rules and regulations governing fishing, sanitation and usage; does related work as required.

### **EXAMPLES OF WORK**

Patrols lakes and properties by boat, by automobile or on foot; checks the possession of valid fishing or boating permits; issues summons to any person found in violation of any law or regulation involving city property; checks general sanitation of lakes or properties and removes animal carcasses or other pollutant matter; assists in making repairs to boats, docks and station buildings; assists in maintaining operating and fiscal records.

### **EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS**

Education and Experience: Any combination of education and experience equivalent to a high school diploma and some experience in work requiring public contact.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: Knowledge of the laws, rules and regulations governing fishing, sanitation and the usage of city-owned lakes and properties; ability to enforce applicable laws and regulations and to apprehend violators; ability to deal tactfully and effectively with the public.

### **SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS**

Possession of a valid North Carolina driver's license.
