

## **LIGHT EQUIPMENT MECHANIC - 643**

### **DEFINITION OF WORK**

Under immediate supervision, performs mechanical work on motorized light equipment; does related work as required.

### **EXAMPLES OF WORK**

Diagnoses, adjusts, repairs and services a wide variety of light equipment, to include chain saw, weedeater, push mower, tractor mower, brush truck, cushman, dump truck, fairway mower, greens mower, flatbed hoist, and the attachments associated with this motorized light equipment; operates various types of shop equipment, machinery, precision instruments, specialized tools and devices such as dynamometers, boring bars, valve refacing and reseating equipment, dial gauges, wheel alignment gauges, clutch cover assembly devices, power saws, grinders, drill presses and lathes; requisitions parts and materials used in the repair of equipment.

### **EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS**

Education and Experience: Any combination of education and experience equivalent to completion of the eleventh grade and some experience in repairing light power-driven equipment.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities: Some knowledge of the construction, design, repair and adjustment of a wide variety of both conventional and specialized light equipment and machinery; knowledge of the usual types of motorized tools and equipment, as well as the special tools, gauges, machinery and shop equipment used in their repair, servicing and maintenance; ability to detect by inspection any worn, defective or improperly adjusted part of the assembly; ability to operate a wide variety of light equipment for testing; ability to follow oral and written instructions and to keep records of repair and service operations.

### **SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS**

Possession of a valid North Carolina driver's license.
