

## **RECREATION MAINTENANCE MECHANIC - 658**

### **DEFINITION OF WORK**

Under immediate supervision, performs semi-skilled work in maintenance, repair and construction work in the City Recreation Department.

### **EXAMPLES OF WORK**

Installs and repairs water fountains; installs and repairs scoreboards; installs and repairs basketball goals; installs and repairs playground equipment; repairs ceramic kilns; repairs faucets, toilets, water lines; recovers pool tables; repairs recreation center games and equipment; winterizes exterior water systems; reconditions and tapes velite to tennis courts; performs minor electrical work; repairs picnic shelters, tables and benches; installs and repairs door closers, locks and doors; pours and finishes concrete; performs routine carpentry work; follows oral and written directions.

### **EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS**

Education and Experience: Any combination of education and experience equivalent to completion of the eleventh grade, with some experience in construction and maintenance.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: General knowledge of maintenance and construction methods, procedures, tools and equipment; general knowledge of electrical and mechanical repair work; ability to follow written and oral instructions and to complete satisfactorily assigned tasks in a timely manner; manual dexterity and good physical condition for heavy work; ability to instruct others.
