

SAFETY INSPECTOR

DEFINITION OF WORK

Under regular supervision; provide safety consulting services for city departments and facilities, and appraises hazards/exposures of worker safety concerns. Assist in developing safety programs.

EXAMPLES OF WORK

Perform inspections of City facilities to evaluate physical conditions in relation to worker safety and determine possible exposures to loss and, develop corrective action work plan. Analyze history of accident and claims and inspects scene of automobile collisions to develop collision prevention recommendations. Confer with City departments to induce compliance with safety standards, codes, and regulations. Develop and frequently deliver training programs to assist City departments in meeting regulatory compliance or for general safety purposes. New Employee participates in safety orientation and completes special projects as requested.

EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS

Education and/Experience: Any combination of education and experience equivalent to a bachelor's degree in Occupational Safety, Safety Engineering or related field and at least 1-3 yrs. of experience in safety consulting, safety management, and safety training.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities: Excellent english oral and written communication. Ability to analyze and calculate mathematical figures. Ability to interpret government regulations. Knowledge of personal computers and related software. Ability to operate photographic and audiovisual equipment. Ability to use noise level dosimeters and basic air sampling equipment.

Special Requirements: Professional certification (CSP, ARM, ALCM, CIH, etc.) strongly recommended but not required. Possession of a valid NC drivers license. Required to lift and/or move 35 pounds and work in all types of weather.
