

## **SANITATION EQUIPMENT OPERATOR**

### **DEFINITION OF WORK**

Under immediate supervision, performs responsible unskilled and semi-skilled work in collection of solid waste; does related work as required.

### **EXAMPLES OF WORK**

Drives refuse truck and supervises, and personally performs, the carting of refuse cans from houses or business establishments and unloads them into the truck; operates mechanisms for loading, compressing and dumping; replaces cans and replaces lids; reports violations of refuse ordinances to supervisor; cleans refuse truck and equipment.

### **EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS**

Education and Experience: Any combination of education and experience equivalent to completion of the seventh grade and some experience in performance of heavy manual work and in the operation of automotive equipment.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: Ability to perform continuous heavy manual work at a rapid pace; ability to operate automotive equipment safely and effectively; ability to understand and follow specific oral instructions; ability to supervise the work of unskilled helpers.

### **SPECIAL REQUIREMENT**

Possession of a valid North Carolina (CDL) Commercial driver's license (Class B).
