

SENIOR METER REPAIRER - 666

DEFINITION OF WORK

Under immediate supervision, performs responsible skilled work in the repair and testing of large compound water meters; does related work as required.

EXAMPLES OF WORK

Performs a variety of complex field tests and repairs on compound water meters; tests meters for various flow rates; disassembles meters; cleans, repairs or replaces all defective parts and reassembles meters; repairs registers, gear trains and measuring chambers; tests and calibrates meters for accuracy after rebuilding them; may maintain records of parts used for meters; installs or removes all sizes of meters in the field; makes cut-ons and cut-offs of customer services; assists in maintaining meter shop and equipment.

EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS

Education and Experience: Any combination of education and experience equivalent to a high school diploma and some experience in the repair and adjustment of water meters or similar mechanical equipment.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: Knowledge of materials and tools used in the repair of water meters; knowledge of principles of water meter operation; ability to disassemble, repair and adjust water meters including large compound meters; ability to follow oral and written directions.
