

SENIOR PLUMBER - 668

DEFINITION OF WORK

Under immediate supervision, performs difficult skilled work in the installation and repair of plumbing lines, fixtures and equipment; does related work as required.

EXAMPLES OF WORK

Supervises and installs new plumbing fixtures and lines in City-owned buildings; makes major repairs to plumbing fixtures and equipment such as faucets, faucet washers, toilets, water fountains, sinks, drains, valves and water lines; unstops drain lines; replaces gas and electric hot water heaters and water coolers; determines operational value of various types of equipment; drains boilers and radiators; keeps records of work and makes reports; trains and assists plumbers and helpers.

EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS

Education and Experience: Any combination of education and experience equivalent to completion of the eleventh grade and extensive experience in plumbing work.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: Thorough knowledge of the methods, tools and equipment used in the installation and repair of sanitary plumbing fixtures and related lines and equipment; thorough knowledge of the operation and minor maintenance of heating equipment; thorough knowledge of applicable plumbing codes; skill in the use of plumbing and pipefitting tools; ability to make time and material estimates; ability to follow oral and written instructions; ability to repair or replace lines and fixtures; ability to plan and supervise the work of skilled workers; ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with other employees.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT

Possession of a valid North Carolina driver's license.
