

TRAFFIC MAINTENANCE WORKER - 743

DEFINITION OF WORK

Under immediate supervision, performs skilled work in the marking of traffic control lines, crosswalks, safety zones, directional signs and similar traffic indicators; does related work as required.

EXAMPLES OF WORK

Lays out lines and patterns for stripping and other markings of streets; sets up cones and caution signs while work is in progress; paints traffic control markings including center lines, lane and turn lines, crosswalks, curbs, stop, yield, school zones, directional signs, driveway lines, parking areas and City property lines; operates paint machine; drives a paint truck; cleans equipment; may assist in sign shop when not painting in streets.

EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS

Education and Experience: Any combination of education and experience equivalent to completion of the eighth grade and some experience in traffic marking and painting work.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: Knowledge of the methods, materials and equipment used in traffic painting and marking of streets; ability to paint lines and markings by hand and with a paint machine; ability to operate a light truck; ability to follow oral and written instructions; ability to observe safety practices; ability to maintain effective working relations with others.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT

Possession of a valid North Carolina driver's license.
