

TRAFFIC SIGN MAKER - 682

DEFINITION OF WORK

Under immediate supervision, performs difficult skilled and routine technical work in the preparation of street signs and related markings; does related work as required.

EXAMPLES OF WORK

Fabricates traffic and related signs including lay-out, stencil cutting, painting and attaching reflectorized material; makes frames for silk screen work and attaches silk to the frames; uses photo equipment and screen for processing signs; hand paints signs including decorative work; makes street name signs using pre-cut letters and letter blanks; paints and stripes barricades and metal drums and old signs; assists with sign maintenance and installation crews; maintains inventory of signs, supplies and materials; manufactures wood signs and operates wood-working equipment.

EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS

Education and Experience: Any combination of education and experience equivalent to a high school diploma and considerable experience in traffic sign maintenance work in commercial sign painting.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: Thorough knowledge of the methods and equipment used in the fabrication of traffic signs, including silk screening techniques; thorough knowledge of applicable drafting methods and commercial art techniques; ability to develop graphic displays and drafting with a minimum of supervision; ability to maintain effective working relationships with other municipal employees and the public.
