23RD ANNUAL YOUNG ARTISTS SHOWCASE
SUBMISSION GUIDELINES
DEADLINE: MARCH 29, 2011

Theme

The 2011 theme **Shaping Your Community for a Greener Future** is an opportunity for you to utilize recycled materials or other 2D media to illustrate the ways you, your community, or your sister city are working to protect the local environment. Your artwork may highlight a problem, issue, or solution important to you, your community, or the world at-large.

Eligibility

- Each participating student artist must be between 13 and 18 years of age at the time the entries are due on April 29, 2011.
- All entries must be the original design and artwork of the entrant. Only new pieces inspired by the theme should be submitted.

Medium & Specifications

- Only two-dimensional artwork, no larger than 24" x 30" (60cm x 75cm), including matting is accepted. Watercolor, oils, pastels, pen and ink, charcoal, photography, two-dimensional mixed media, as well as computer generated art, are all acceptable media.
- Entries that use copyrighted or trademarked images will not be accepted.
- Entries must not be plagiarized, stolen, or copied from any other source. Entries from previous years will not be accepted. Entries must not defame or invade the rights of any person, living or dead. Entries not adhering to these guidelines will not be considered.

Thank you for your interest in Sister-Cities Winston-Salem's 2011 "Young Artist Showcase". Deadline for Winston-Salem entries is March 29. The top City representative art work will be entered in the Sister-Cities International Showcase.

Entries to the Winston-Salem Annual Young Artist Showcase will be on exhibit at a downtown location. There will be an awards presentation to one young artist per school who's work best illustrates the theme of this year's showcase; "Shaping Your Community for a Greener Future".

Please comply with the above guidelines. Note that for middle schools the artist must be at least 13 years of age at the time of submission.
